This spectacular new itinerary for 2024 is a fly/drive combination featuring all the highlights of Northern Tanzania. After an arrival night in Arusha you visit the wilderness of Tarangire park, synonymous for large herds of elephants. Continue on to Lake Manyara Park, famed for it's tree climbing lions. Thereafter discover the 8th wonder of the world, the magnificent Ngorongoro Crater. Finally you head into the sensational Serengeti as your last stop, home of the annual great wildebeest migration, before flying back to Arusha. This small group trip is guaranteed for a minimum of 2 clients with weekly departures. Can be extended by light aircraft flight to Northern Serengeti, Selous or beach destination, as required

Day 01 Sunday

Arriving at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you clear customs and immigration formalities and are met outside opposite the Arrivals Hall by our representative. They will assist you to your transfer vehicle for your transfer to the hotel. Accommodation Gran Meliá Arusha Hotel in deluxe city view rooms on bed and breakfast basis (excludes other meals, drinks, and laundry)

An oasis within Arusha set in 18 acres of beautiful, landscaped coffee and tea plantations. Pure tranquillity with spectacular views of Mount Meru. Gran Meliá Arusha offers a unique experience with luxuriously decorated rooms and a variety of dining options.

Modern design inspired by the local Tanzanian tribes and emulating the rich coffee bean colours. All the rooms have their own private balcony to enjoy the beautiful, lush views over Arusha City and take in the red skies of the African sunset. Each room is equipped with a king-size bed or two single beds, television, minibar, free Wi-Fi, and air-conditioning.

Day 02

Following breakfast and your safari briefing, you depart by 4x4 safari vehicle to Tarangire National Park. Once you pass the park gate, you game view en route to the lodge arriving for lunch. Following lunch and a chance to enjoy the lodge's facilities, you have an afternoon game drive returning to the lodge for dinner and overnight.

Tarangire Ndovu Tented Lodge Tented Rooms

Tarangire Ndovu Tented Lodge is located in the heart of Tarangire National Park, Tanzania's wild land of elephant herds and landscapes. At Tarangire Ndovu Tented Lodge, there 12 permanent tents providing an intimate experience in the wild.

The camp is open all year around and especially during the dry months, the massive elephant herds travel through the corridor between Manyara and Tarangire and spend their time in and around the park. This is because of their ability to uncover permanent sources of fresh water. We endeavour to retain the uniqueness and intimacy of the camp, while being directed by the location, wildlife and other factors of responsible tourism. Each tent is framed with wooden logs, metal piping and then wrapped in heavy duty safari rip-stop canvas made locally at Morogoro, southern Tanzania, plus the additional cooling feature of shade-clothing over the entire tent. You are met at the entrance by climbing specially crafted stairs and onto a balcony with love seat and side table for relaxing when you have a moment. The front of the tents have double sliding doors, including a layer of mosquito netting for your comfort. Once you step into the tent and the bedroom area, you will see an arrangement of unique furniture like a desk and chair, bench seat, side tables, matting and incredible local imagery. Once you walk through the bedroom and into the ensuite, the polished concrete floors with wardrobe, robes, separate shower and toilet cubicles and handcrafted washstand with carefully created terracotta basins. All the fittings depict colours in natural tones to adhere to the intrinsic area we are located.

Day 03

Morning and afternoon game drives with meals and overnight at the lodge.

Accommodation Tarangire Ndovu Tented Lodge on full board basis including all meals, bottled/filtered water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits (excludes premium drinks and laundry)

Day 04

Depart to Lake Manyara and the Great Rift Valley region. Stop at Ol Mesera Manyara Restaurant in Mto wa Mbu for lunch (excludes drinks) with Makonde carving show and experience. Then continue to Ngorongoro Conservation Area arriving at the lodge in the afternoon for a chance to enjoy the views of the Ngorongoro Crater. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Accommodation Melia Ngorongoro Lodge in Premiere Forest View Rooms on full board basis including all meals, bottled/filtered water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits (excludes premium drinks and laundry)

Optional Experience

Guests who wish to have an escorted walk on the crater rim with a conservation officer can make these arrangements in advance. The walk is about 2 hours and is strenuous due to the altitude of the crater rim.

Day 05

Early departure and descend to the floor of the Ngorongoro Crater. You game drive in this paradise. With a space of only 102 square miles and a resident wildlife population of more than 30,000 mammals, there is a great chance that you might see all the big five. A picnic lunch box is provided at a scenic picnic site within the crater. In the afternoon, you return to the rim of the crater and your lodge for dinner and overnight.

Accommodation Meliá Ngorongoro Lodge in Premiere Forest View Rooms on full board basis including all meals, bottled/filtered water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits (excludes premium drinks and laundry)

Day 06

Depart to Serengeti National Park arriving at the lodge for lunch. You stop at Olduvai Gorge for a chance to see the site where the Leakey family made several important archaeological discoveries. A small museum with some of the artifacts found can be viewed. You also visit a cultural Maasai village. Continue into Serengeti National Park and a hot lunch provided at the Miracle Experience Seronera restaurant (from set menu) (excludes drinks). Following lunch, you depart and head west towards the Mbalageti Hills with game viewing en route viewing the abundant wildlife. Arrive at your lodge in the late afternoon for time to freshen up followed by dinner and overnight.

Day 08

You have a choice of early morning, morning and afternoon game drives with meals at the lodge or depart on a full day game drive with picnic lunch. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Accommodation Meliá Serengeti Lodge in Lagoon View Rooms on full board basis including all meals, bottled/filtered water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits (excludes premium drinks and laundry)

Day 09

Final game drive en route to Seronera airstrip. Fly by scheduled flight to Arusha Airport (included) departing 11:00 arriving 12:20. You are met on arrival and transferred to Saana Restaurant for lunch (from set menu) (excludes drinks). Then transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport for your departure flight (flight not included)

Option: Transfer to Seronera airstrip for flight to Northern Serengeti, Masai Mara, Nyerere or beach, at supplement.
